#### PURPOSE AND CRITERIA

The scholarship was developed by the members of Avon Lions Club to honor and remember the last charter member of the club for his selfless devotion to Lionism and the Avon community. Bill Bommer, Sr. was a strong and active member of the Avon Lions Club for over fifty (50) years and an outspoken believer in getting involved in making Avon a better place to live for all. We honor his memory and efforts today with the Avon Lions Club - William H. Bommer Memorial Scholarship.

Lionism is a dedication to the highest of humanitarian service: a fellowship of men and women who have committed themselves to aiding those in need through whatever means at their disposal. Lionism is a faith that people of different nationalities and creeds, separated by borders, oceans and old distrusts, can join together in helping to bring about a better world. It is indeed a way life. Lionism is a set of principles by which one lives: a guideline for community service, ethical business responsibilities and inter-personal relations.

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial assistance for qualified high school seniors from the Avon, Ohio community that will be enrolling in a two or four year college program.

When selecting undergraduate scholarship recipients, special consideration may be given to parents with dependent children who demonstrate financial need. Academic achievement, community service and/or job performance will also be considered.

#### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

To be eligible for scholarship consideration, the applicant must be a current high school senior, scheduled to be a May or June graduate, and must satisfy one of the following criteria:

- (1) Must be a student at Avon High School; or
- (2) Must be a resident of the city of Avon enrolled in a private or parochial school; or
- (3) Must be an immediate family member and a financial dependent of an Avon Lions Club member in good standing.

Final acceptance and approval of any Avon Lions Club scholarship requires that the recipient attend a regularly scheduled Club meeting for the award presentation. The Club will award this year <u>two (2) \$1,000 dollar scholarships</u> based on various information provided in the application, financial need, declared major, educational goals, etc.

Applicant must have a **3.00 GPA or higher**, good attendance record in high school, demonstrated participation in community service projects, and involvement in extracurricular activities (sports, clubs, and/or organizations).

The Avon Lions Club reserves the right to alter or change the scholarship levels and the number of scholarships awarded as deemed appropriate by the Board of Trustees of the Avon Lions Club.

#### SCHOLARSHIP CANCELLATION

Failure to attend, complete or drop-out of school voids the scholarship funding and the scholarship becomes immediately forfeited. The Club expects that scholarship funds would be returned on a timely basis to allow another qualified applicant an opportunity to further their education in the spirit of Lionism.
