



2021 AVON LIONS CLUB WILLIAM H. BOMMER SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship was developed by the members of Avon Lions Club to honor and remember the last charter member of the club for his selfless devotion to Lion-ism and the Avon community. Bill Bommer, Sr. was a strong and active member of the Avon Lions Club for over fifty (50) years and an outspoken believer in getting involved in making Avon a better place to live for all. We honor his memory and efforts today with the Avon Lions Club - William H. Bommer Memorial Scholarship.

Lion-ism is a dedication to the highest of humanitarian service: a fellowship of men and women who have committed themselves to aiding those in need through whatever means at their disposal. Lion-ism is a faith that people of different nationalities and creeds, separated by borders, oceans and old distrusts, can join in helping to bring about a better world. It is indeed a way life. Lion-ism is a set of principles by which one lives: a guideline for community service, ethical business responsibilities and inter-personal relations.

SELECTION CRITERIA

To be eligible for scholarship consideration, the applicant **must be a current high school senior, scheduled to be a May or June graduate**, and must satisfy **the following criteria**:

- (1) Must be a student at Avon High School; or
- (2) Must be a resident of the city of Avon enrolled in a private or parochial school; or
- (3) Must be an immediate family member and a financial dependent of an Avon Lions Club member in good standing.
- (4) Must have 3.50 GPA or higher and been involved in extracurricular activities

The Club will award **two (2) \$1,000-dollar scholarships** based on various information provided in the application, financial need, declared major, educational goals, etc. Final acceptance and approval of any Avon Lions Club scholarship requires that the recipient attend a scheduled Club meeting for the award presentation

Documentation that must be submitted (see last page of application for more information)

- **Completed application** with certification signed by applicant and 1 parent
- **Criteria Items** Extracurricular Activities, Community Service and Work Experience (show dates)
- **Student Statement** about your educational plans and how this scholarship will assist you in your goals
- **One Recommendation Letter** from your high school guidance advisor or teacher,
- **Current High School transcript**

Selected applicants will receive a telephone call requesting additional information in order to process the scholarship funding.

On a separate page, describe your educational plan, your career goals and any personal circumstances, which would illustrate a need for financial assistance. Also, indicate how the scholarship will help you reach your goals.
